
The ENE Network

ENE is unique in being an international network of <u>Centres of Vocational</u> <u>Excellence (CoVEs)</u>.

It has more than 270 COVEs, and more than 40 countries worldwide: 15 ETF Partner Countries; 10 EU Member States; 14 African (Sub–Saharan countries); Switzerland and Philippines.

During 2023, ENE thematic work is currently building on 10 themes. These are captured in ENE Self–Assessment Tool (ENESAT):

- Lifelong learning in vocational education and training from initial to continuing training and adult education pathways–from VET to Higher Education (and vice versa).
- Entrepreneurial Centres of Vocational Excellence.
- Education-business cooperation.
- Pedagogy and Professional Development.

- Going green supporting sustainable goals.
